

The Self-Assessment Report

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Program Assessment is an organized process of gathering, reviewing and using important quantitative and qualitative data and information from multiple and diverse sources about educational programs, for the purpose of improving student learning, and evaluating whether academic and learning standards are being met. The process culminates when assessment results are used to improve student learning. A successful assessment program includes the following:

1. Purpose identification
2. Outcomes identification
3. Measurements and evaluation design
4. Data collection
5. Analysis and evaluation
6. Decision-making regarding actions to be taken.

The Self-Assessment Report is a document which can facilitate the stakeholders to evaluate it from all perspectives and identify minor weaknesses and pathways for rectification. Inputs of the Academic Program are: Curriculum, students, infrastructure, processes and, most importantly faculty. Whereas output is the Graduate as a Product. There are 31 standards to assess the quality of a program.

In this workshop, participants will be able to understand the criteria and standards required for assessment of an academic program and assurance of its quality of a program. It will enable the Participants to differentiate all components of a Strategic Plan and its impact on the academic program. The Self-Assessment Report process facilitates involvement of Stakeholders in preparation for Program Accreditation.
